#### **Highlands College Granted Accreditation**

On February 14, Highlands College met an extraordinary benchmark in biblical higher education. After close collaboration and continuous review over the last ten years, the Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE) granted Highlands College accreditation—aligning with the college's strategic plan to transition to an immersive academy model that offers an accredited baccalaureate program to the rising generation of ministry leaders. Students who graduated this May were the first to graduate with an accredited Associate of Arts in Ministry Leadership degree.

#### **New Degree Offerings Launch this Fall**

After being granted accreditation by the ABHE, the State of Alabama approved Highlands College to award seven ministry-focused bachelor's degree programs. This Fall, 167 incoming students began coursework to earn one of the following degrees:

In the countries where we invest, Scripture engagement and Bible translation projects are impacting 902,411,483 individuals.

Through our partners, 1,241 churches were planted globally.

6,096 individuals experienced Kingdom-minded leadership development and training.

Globally, 47 unreached people groups heard the Gospel and were given Scripture for the first time.
