Campus Opening and Growth

Thanks to the generosity of Highlands College donors, several new campus developments have been made possible this fall and will be available starting spring 2023. Weekly Chapel services and Practicum training moved to the adjoining Grandview Campus auditorium at the beginning of November. Phase one of on-campus sports and wellness center programs are launching this spring. Highlands College's very first residence hall is also completed and will bring 24-7 life to campus this coming spring semester.

Expanded Opportunities to Visit Campus

Since the new Highlands College campus opened in January 2022, hundreds of prospective students and their families have had expanded opportunities to visit campus and learn more about Highlands College as their potential next step through personalized Campus Visits and monthly Preview Day experiences. Thousands of guests from GrowLeader, Motion Student Conference, Student Leadership Days, and other leadership events have seen and heard the ways God is moving through Highlands College and preparing students for a lifetime of ministry leadership.

Expanded In-Residence Program

Highlands College is honored to add two leaders to their In-Residence Program, expanding the incredible list of ministry leaders who invest their expertise and experience in Highlands College students, building more well-rounded leaders. Pastor Bobby Gruenewald, Life Church Pastor of Innovation and Founder and CEO of YouVersion Bible App, joined the program as the Visionary-in-Residence. New York Times Best Selling author of *The Traveler's Gift* and other works, Andy Andrews, became the program's first Author-in-Residence.

Advancements in the Accreditation Process

At the end of September, an Evaluation Visiting Team from the Association of Biblical Higher Education (ABHE) met with students and the Highlands College team on campus for one of the final steps in Highlands College's accreditation process—a milestone for the college. After receiving institutional accreditation, anticipated in the spring of 2023, Highlands College's Strategic Plan prioritizes immediately pursuing approval to offer a bachelor's degree.

We believe every person deserves the opportunity to hear the Gospel of Jesus and to have a Bible in their native language. We are helping to plant more new churches worldwide and partnering with organizations that are translating the Bible into new languages.

In the countries where we invest, Scripture engagement and Bible translation projects are impacting **675,150,000** individuals.

Through our partners, **2,795** churches were planted globally.

1,240 individuals experienced Kingdom-minded leadership development and training.

Globally, **361** unreached people groups heard the Gospel and were given Scripture for the first time.

Through our ministry partners, **5,582,310** individuals were served with humanitarian needs and resources.

Over **1,930,344** meals were served globally to those in need.
