Giving to Highlands College provides scholarships, enhanced academic programs, and state-of-the-art training grounds for Christian leaders in ministry and the marketplace for generations to come.

As of October 2025, **1,395** graduates have been launched into **375** churches and ministries, across **36** states, the District of Columbia, **1** U.S. territory, and **23** countries.

Eternal Impact Campaign:

November 1, 2025 marked the campaign's **eighth** anniversary, with over **\$176.7 million** in commitments to fund the mission, vision, and goals of Highlands College. In **2025** alone, over **862** new donors and **4,990** gifts were given to date.

As Highlands College makes progress towards funding the Perpetual Purpose Endowment (PPE), they are working to raise an annual amount of \$15,000,000 for student assistance & operational support. This will allow them to fulfill their commitment to provide students every opportunity to graduate debt-free and replace government funding previously utilized by students.

Vision Milestones:

Fall 2025: Largest Incoming Class & First Senior Class

This fall, Highlands College welcomed the largest incoming class in school history, with 205 freshmen joining the HC Family and bringing enrollment to over 500 students—a 28% year-over-year increase with 88% retention. Representing 39 states, and a majority being of out-of-state students, this record class reflects the College's expanding national reach. Fall 2025 also marks the launch of Highlands College's first senior class, advancing the vision to educate 1,000 students by 2029.

In February 2025, the Office of Ministry Placement launched the Highlands College Alumni Network, offering graduates an engaging digital platform to stay connected, encouraged, and resourced. National Outreach

Highlands Resources:

This year, Church of the Highlands successfully launched the new Highlands Resources online platform. Prior to launching the new platform, 125,557 resources were downloaded, making that a total of 2,770,000 downloads since the site's launch. We are hopeful for the new platform to continue to help us resource and grow the local church.

Through these resources, we have accomplished the vision of "helping 1,000 churches break the 1,000 in attendance barrier", with a confirmed **1,015 churches** that have broken 1,000 in Sunday attendance since engaging with Highlands Resources!

In the countries where we invest, Scripture engagement and Bible translation projects are impacting **528,227,336** individuals.

Through our partners, 23,351 churches have been planted globally in 2025.

43,502 individuals experienced Kingdom-minded leadership development and training.

Globally, 682 unreached people groups heard the Gospel and were given Scripture for the first time.

Through our ministry partners, 3,020,020 individuals were served with resources to meet humanitarian needs.

Over 4,779,589 meals were served to those in need globally.
